



Official Regulation — Entre Tercios

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MULTIPLY YOUR PASSION

1. General Description

Entre Tercios is a peer-to-peer game where players propose and lay their own predictions on horse racing events. Lígalo acts as a neutral intermediary: it holds the funds in escrow, matches proposers with layers, and settles results automatically after the official closing of each race.

Unlike traditional games, there is no house setting the odds. The proposer posts a play with a chosen amount and other users decide how much they wish to lay. Payout is 1:1 on the matched amount, minus only the platform commission.

Entre Tercios is available to all authenticated users who have the module permission active and authorization for the corresponding tracks.

2. Available Sub-markets

- **Horse vs Horse (CvC):** the proposer picks two horses from the same race. The play is won by whoever selected the horse that finishes ahead of the other, regardless of the final position within the race.
- **Positions (Puestos):** the proposer picks a horse and a predefined finishing-position odd (for example 1P, 2P, 3P, 1-2, 1-3). The play is validated if the horse finishes in the position indicated by the selected odd.

Both sub-markets share the same propose, lay and settle flow described below.

3. Settlement Table — Positions

The following table describes the outcomes and settlement for each odd available on the Positions sub-market. The rules apply to the horse chosen by the proposer. The settlement shown is the proposer's net win if the odd is met; the layer receives the matched amount minus the house commission when the odd fails.

If you lay (banker side)

You win the amount you laid when the player fails the odd, minus the house commission.

4. Game Flow

- Propose: the player selects the track, race day and race. Then chooses the sub-market (CvC or Positions), the selection (horses or odd) and the USD amount to play.
- Wait for lay: the proposal is published in the open proposals list, visible to all other eligible players. The player may check their proposals at any time and keep them active until the race closes.
- Lay: any other eligible player may take a portion or the full amount of the proposal. The layer freely chooses how much to risk, within the remaining available amount.
- Automatic settlement: once the race officially closes, the system determines the outcome, pays the winning side and applies the platform commission over the matched amount. Unmatched remainders are automatically refunded.

5. Laying and 1:1 Payout

Matching is 1 to 1: for every dollar laid, the proposer commits one dollar of the total amount. There is no payout factor or artificial odd. The winner takes the loser's money minus the applicable commission.

The layer may take the full amount of a proposal or only a fraction. It is perfectly valid for multiple layers to cover different fractions of the same proposal.

Practical example: player A proposes 100 USD on a CvC. Player B lays 40 USD and player C lays 30 USD. 70 USD are matched. If A wins, they receive 70 USD (minus commission). If B and C win, they take A's 70 USD proportionally (minus commission). The remaining 30 USD from A that were never laid are automatically refunded to A's account.

6. Automatic Refund of Unmatched Amounts

At the time the race closes, if a proposal has an amount that was not laid by any player, that residual balance is automatically returned to the proposer's account.

The refund is reflected in the movement history and generates no commission. Commission is charged only on the effectively matched amount.

Example: if player A proposed 100 USD and only 70 USD were laid, at closing they receive an immediate 30 USD refund.

7. Platform Commission

Lígalo applies a 3% commission on the matched amount to the winner of each match. This commission is the only cost of participation and is deducted solely from the winning side's payout.

The current percentage is always visible in the proposals interface, alongside the detail of the amount to be charged.

The commission is configurable by the administration. Any change is announced in advance and applies only to proposals created after the adjustment.

8. Track and Race Selection

- Proposals are made on open races of the current race day.
- Races close approximately 2 minutes before the official post time. After closing, no new proposals or lays are accepted on that race.
- Available tracks: Entre Tercios is enabled for all tracks the user is authorized to access in their profile. Users without permission for national tracks (La Rinconada, Valencia) will not see those tracks in the selector.
- Global list: players can view all active open proposals in a unified list, with filters by sub-market and track, and a button to hide their own proposals.

9. Results, Cancellations and Scratches

- The official result comes from the order of finish reported by the data source of the corresponding track.
- If any of the horses involved in a CvC is scratched before the race, all matches on that proposal are refunded in full to both parties, with no commission.
- If a horse selected in a Positions play is scratched before the race, the proposal is refunded to both parties.
- If the race is cancelled or declared void by the track, all matches are refunded with no commission.
- In case of a technical tie (dead heat) in a CvC between the two selected horses, the play is refunded to both parties.

10. Multi-Currency

- USD is the system's internal base currency. All matches, commissions and refunds are calculated in USD.
- Additional currencies (VES, COP, DOP, EUR) are accepted with automatic conversion using the current exchange rate at the time the proposal is created or laid.
- The exchange rate is recorded at the time of each transaction, ensuring historical integrity.



11. Loyalty Program

- All proposals and lays generate Ligalo Points (LP).
- 1 LP is awarded per 1 USD effectively matched.
- LP accumulate both on wins and on losses.
- LP contribute to the user's VIP level and can be redeemed according to the Loyalty Program rules.

12. General Rules

- Minimum and maximum amounts per proposal are configurable by the administration and are visible in the interface.
- Multiple accounts are not allowed. The platform reserves the right to cancel suspicious proposals or lays.
- Persons under 18 years of age are not authorized to participate.
- Lígalo Internacional reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. Changes will be notified to users.
- In case of any dispute, the decision of Lígalo Internacional's administration is final.
