Official Regulations — Parlay Hípico

Horse Racing — Lígalo Internacional

MULTIPLY YOUR PASSION

1. General Description

The Parlay Hípico is a combined betting format that allows users to group multiple horse racing selections into a single wager. Each individual selection is referred to as a "leg" of the parlay.

- A minimum of 2 legs (selections) is required to create a Parlay Hípico.
- Legs may come from different races within the same track or from different tracks.
- The main advantage of the parlay is that the odds multiply together, generating significantly higher payouts compared to individual bets.
- To win the Parlay Hípico, ALL included selections must be winners (except those that result in PUSH, as detailed below).

2. How Does It Work?

The process for placing a Parlay Hípico on the Lígalo En Línea platform is as follows:

- The user navigates to the Horse Racing section and selects the races of interest.
- For each race, the user chooses the bet type (Win, GPS, Match Up, etc.) and the desired horse or selection.
- Each selection is automatically added to the parlay ticket.
- The total parlay odds are calculated in real time as the product of all individual odds.
- The user sets the wager amount and confirms the bet.

Important: Each leg of the parlay must correspond to a different race. Two selections from the same race cannot be included in a single parlay.

3. Eligible Selection Types

The following horse racing bet types may be included as legs of a Parlay Hípico:

- Win — Bet on the horse that will finish in first place.
- GPS (Win/Place/Show) — Bet that the horse will finish 1st, in the top 2, or in the top 3, respectively.
- Match Ups — Direct head-to-head bet between two horses. The user bets on which of the two will finish in a better position.
- Other simple horse racing bets available on the platform that are compatible with the parlay format.

Note: Exotic bets (Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta) and pool bets (Liga 6, Reto 6, Super Polla) are NOT eligible as legs of a Parlay Hípico.

4. Minimum and Maximum Legs

- Minimum legs: 2 selections. Every parlay must include at least two legs from different races.
- Maximum legs: There is no predefined maximum limit on the number of legs. However, the platform's maximum payout limits apply to the total parlay payout.
- The platform reserves the right to establish a maximum payout per parlay ticket, which will be communicated to users accordingly.

5. Payout Calculation

The Parlay Hípico payout is calculated by multiplying all individual odds of each leg together, then multiplying the result by the wagered amount.

Formula:

Payout = Wagered Amount × (Odds Leg 1 × Odds Leg 2 × ... × Odds Leg N)

Example with 3 legs:

- Leg 1 (Win, Race 3 — Gulfstream): Odds 2.40
- Leg 2 (Match Up, Race 5 — Churchill Downs): Odds 1.77
- Leg 3 (Win, Race 7 — Belmont): Odds 3.10

Total parlay odds = $2.40 \times 1.77 \times 3.10 = 13.16$

If the wagered amount is \$10 USD → Total payout = $\$10 \times 13.16 = \131.60 USD

All legs must be winners to collect the parlay payout. If a single leg loses, the entire parlay is a loss.

6. Horse Scratches in Match Ups (Scratch / PUSH)

If either horse involved in a MATCH UP included as a leg of the PARLAY HÍPICO is scratched (withdrawn), that selection is treated as a PUSH (tie). The parlay is automatically recalculated without that leg. If all legs result in PUSH, the full wagered amount is refunded.

Detailed Scratch/PUSH rules:

- If a horse involved in a Match Up is scratched (withdrawn) before or during the race, that parlay leg is declared a PUSH (tie).
- The odds of the PUSH leg are removed from the parlay calculation. The parlay remains active with the remaining legs.
- If active (non-PUSH) legs remain, the payout is recalculated using only the odds of the active legs.
- If ALL legs of the parlay result in PUSH, the full wagered amount (100%) is refunded to the user.
- Legs declared as PUSH are not considered winners or losers.

Recalculation example due to Scratch/PUSH:

- Original 3-leg parlay: Odds $2.40 \times 1.77 \times 3.10 = 13.16$
- Leg 2 (Match Up) has a scratch → declared PUSH.
- New parlay odds = $2.40 \times 3.10 = 7.44$
- If you wagered \$10 and Legs 1 and 3 win → Payout = $\$10 \times 7.44 = \74.40 USD

7. Settlement

The Parlay Hípico is settled (resolved) once ALL races included as legs have finished and their results are official.

- The parlay is a WINNER only if all active (non-PUSH) legs are winners.
- The parlay is a LOSER if at least one active leg loses. A single losing leg is enough to make the entire parlay a loss.

- Legs that result in PUSH (due to scratches in Match Ups) do not count as winners or losers. They are simply removed from the calculation.
- Payouts are automatically credited to the user's balance once the parlay is settled as a winner.
- In the event of an official race suspension or cancellation, the corresponding leg will be treated as a PUSH.

8. Loyalty Program (Ligalo Points)

- All Parlay Hípico bets generate Ligalo Points (LP).
- 1 LP is awarded for every \$1 USD wagered.
- LP accumulate on both wins and losses.
- LP contribute to your VIP level and can be redeemed according to the Loyalty Program rules.

9. General and Important Rules

- Amounts are handled in US dollars (USD) as the base currency. Multiple currencies are accepted (VES, COP, DOP, EUR) with automatic conversion.
- Multiple accounts are not allowed. The platform reserves the right to cancel suspicious bets.
- Persons under 18 years of age are not authorized to participate in real-money wagering.
- Lígalo En Línea reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. Changes will be communicated to users.
- In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Lígalo Internacional administration is final.
